

Miller Fails to Threaten

Tars' Tom Stewart Tops Individuals

Strength in the mile and half-mile brought Cooley High School its second straight City League indoor track championship at Central Friday.

The Cardinals, who won the crown for the sixth time in 10 years, picked up first and third places in each of the distance events to account for more than half of their 38-point total.

MILLER, which was expected to fight Cooley to the final event, dropped out of the contention early in the meet. Aaron Gordon, the league's cross-country champion, fell and went unplaced in the mile to end Miller's hopes.

The Trojans ripped Denby for secondary honors with 31 1/2 points, however. The Tars scored 31 points, Redford 21 1/2, Northwestern 21, Western 17 1/2, Eastern 10, Southeastern 9, Hamtramck 7 1/2, Mackenzie 4 1/2, Southwestern 2 1/2, Pershing 3 and Northern 2 1/2.

Denby's relay team of Harry Bearse, Don Keller, Bruno Boelstler and Tom Stewart produced the meet's only record. They toured the 880-yard distance in 1:35.8, clipping .7 seconds off the mark shared by Central and Northwestern.

STEWART ALSO picked up first places in the high and low hurdles and a tie for second in the pole vault. He accounted for more than half of the Tars' total points.

In winning the low hurdle event, Stewart equaled the league's standard, negotiating the distance in .04. Western's Bob Jackson tied the .04.2 mark for the high hurdles.
