

Shot Putters Steal Show

Records Set in Two Divisions at Relays

ANN ARBOR—A pair of shot putters stole the show in the early events of the eighth annual River Rouge High School Relays in Yost Field House.

K. D. McKinnon, Saginaw High senior, threw the ball 50 feet 2 inches to establish a Class A record and send the Trojans into an early lead.

SAGINAW ENTERED the meet a co-favorite with its crosstown rival, Arthur Hill. The Trojans piled up 13 points in the first two events as its medley relay team of James Bond, Dick Terzia, William Conley and Bob Parson won in 8:11.1.

McKinnon's meet record was short-lived, however. A few minutes later John Koczman, Milan senior, put the shot an even 51 feet in the Class C-D division.

Koczman's effort was 22 inches better than the State Class C record of 49 feet 2 inches established by John Bocek, of Corunna, in 1941.

YPSILANTI Central scored 12 points in the first four events to hold a slight lead in Class B, while Ypsilanti Roosevelt's 10 points in four events was a half-point better than Fowlerville's 9½ in the C-D bracket.
