

Area Track Teams Shine In Albion Invitational

Albion — Battle Creek Central kept its Class A title, while two Ypsilanti schools, Central in Class B and Roosevelt in Class C, dethroned Charlotte and Romulus High Schools, respectively, in Saturday's Albion College Invitational High School track meet.

Flint area teams made an excellent showing with Fenton finishing in a fifth place tie with Battle Creek Lake View in Class B team scoring with 18 points. Grand Blanc totaled 11, and Mt. Morris 8.

George Howe of Fenton won the Class B mile for the second

for third in the high jump while teammates John Swartz was second in the pole vault and tied straight year in 4:39.3, while Charles Franks took the 880 in 2:08.7. Franks finished second in this event in 1946. Fenton thirds were scored by Allen Gale in the 440-yard dash and Frank Winn in the low hurdles.

Duane Quick paced the Mt. Morris crew with a second in the half mile while Dean Elleman got fourths in both Class B dashes. Grand Blanc's Bill Teer placed fourth in the mile run and Ron Weir won fourth in broad jump.
