The Big Reds took seven firsts to six for Eastern, and collected seven seconds to five for the Quakers, with one a tie. The Reds also had an edge in thirds at 6-4, and a tie.</p> <p>The star of the meet was Eastern's Bob Nagel, who took three of the Quakers' six first places. He won both dashes and the pole vault, besides running on the sprint relay team, where he picked up 10 yards on Vern Vannerson, Sexton anchor man, only to lose by half a step.</p> <p>Sexton's five firsts besides the two relays were won by Charley Stanton in the high jump, Grene Frazier in the broad jump, Jim Foster in the high hurdles, Linton Stewart in the 440 and Doug Nichols in the low hurdles. Vannerson was second to Nagel in both dashes and was only a step behind in the 220.</p> <p>Eastern's other three firsts were by Ken Maleitzke in the 880, in the fast time of 2:06.9; by John Bond in the mile; and by Irving Korroch in the shot put.</p> <p>Roger Toebe, Dave Eppley and Dick Compson gave Sexton a 3-2 edge in the singles of the tennis match, against Eastern's wins by Charles Puffer and Don Nixon. Steve Bransdorfer and Dave Page then sewed it up for the Big Reds in the first of the two doubles.</p> <p>The Sexton golfers turned in their best total of the year to take the match at Groesbeck. Don Perne led the way with an 82, Bob Fairman had 87, Larry French 89 and Chuck Bopf 90. George Wakulsky was low for Eastern with an 84.</p>
