

Trojans Top East Siders

Miller Leads Denby in Prep Track Meet

Denby and Miller, East Side track kings, showed their heels to seven other league rivals Wednesday in the first section of the City League's outdoor quarterfinals.

While only half of the standard 12 events were run off in the initial session, Miller took a 12½-point lead over Denby, defending East Side indoor titlist.

THE TROJANS, who walked off with first in the mile and 440, amassed 38 points in the six events, followed by Denby with 25½, Cass 16½, Pershing 15, Southeastern 12, Hamtramck 6½, Northern 6, Northeastern 4 and Eastern 2½.

Denby's Tommy Stewart unofficially cracked the league's 220 mark. He was clocked in :22, one-tenth of a second better than the official record.

Redford's Gordon Cronk captured three places for the Huskies, leading the field in the 220, 100 and broad jump.
