

## District Track Stars Rate In State Meet

Four District athletes scored points for their school in the Michigan track and field meet Saturday in East Lansing.

Imlay City's Durow gave Imlay City fifth place in the class C championships by scoring a first in the 120-yard high hurdles, a second in the 200-yard low hurdles, and a tie for second in the pole vault for a total of  $14\frac{1}{2}$  points.

Jack McKay, Port Huron High, finished fourth in the class A 200-yard low hurdles; Anderson, Bad Axe, in a tie for second in the class C pole vault, and Thompson, Yale, placed fourth in the class B 440-yard dash.

Port Huron's total was 3 points, Bad Axe got  $3\frac{1}{2}$ , and Yale 1.

In the class A event in which McKay placed fourth, a new record was set—22.6 seconds.

A new record—23 seconds—also was set in the class C 200-yard low hurdles in which Doro placed second. The Imlay City star won the high hurdles in 15.7 seconds.

Saginaw High School swept to six first places and scored  $42\frac{1}{3}$  points while winning its third straight class A championship. Flint Central was second with 31, while Saginaw Arthur Hill had  $27\frac{5}{6}$ , Battle Creek  $20\frac{1}{2}$  and Jackson 20.
