

# Pobojewski Takes Sixth In State Shotput Finals

Grand Rapids and Grand Valley track athletes did not fare so well during the morning events at the state finals being held in East Lansing Saturday.

Rasikas, Creston's entry in the century, placed second in his trial heat that was won in 10.2. Foley of Creston and Lock of Ottawa failed to place in their heats.

Dan Pobojewski of Catholic Central garnered the only Grand Rapids point captured during the morning, taking sixth in the shotput with a heave of 45 feet 1 3/4 inches. McKinnon of Saginaw won the event with a toss of 52 feet 5 1/2 inches.

Rasikas won his heat in the 220-

yard dash, besting his competitor with a time of 22.6. Neither Foley nor Gibson, the latter of Catholic, could place in their trials.

In the high jump Bonine and Hook of Ottawa fell out at 5 feet 6 inches. Verbrugge of Catholic also faltered at that mark. A height of 6 feet or better was expected to be reached.

Rose of Creston is expected to have a good chance to place in the 440, while Crowley of Catholic, Lucas of Central and Gravelyn of Creston looked as though they might win points in the pole vault.

Tod Heyman of East Grand Rapids placed third in the 120 high hurdle trials in class B.

Grandville's Keith Little qualified in the highs, taking third in his heat, while Gerry Vredevelt placed second in the 100-yard dash heat in class C. Vredevelt won his heat in the 220 and Dennis of Rockford placed second in another heat that was ran in 23.6.

Myslenski of Central, Boylan of Creston and Rowerink of Ottawa failed to qualify in the hurdle events.
