ANN ARBOR, April 16.—River Rouge High's tenth annual open track meet turned into a carnival of record-smashing in Yost Field-house tonight. Twelve marks were broken and three others equalled as 850 athletes from 80 schools contested for trophies, medals and ribbons in the country's largest one-day scholastic competition.

Two records were set and one tied in Class A, four broken and one equalled in B, five broken and two tied in Class C.D.

Four of the record breakers, all in Class B, were from Detroit area schools. Eugene Johnson River Rouge leaped 5 feet of River Rouge leaped 5 2001 11% inches in the high jump; Dick Fisher, Trenton, put the shot 48 feet 7 inches; Jim Wagenschultz, Plymouth, cleared 11 feet 6 in the pole vault and Dale Davis, Belleville, turned in a 4:40.2 mile. The Plymouth runturned ner's time was not only a mark for the class but also surpassed the Class A record.
