

**Sexton Beaten
On Pontiac Track**

PONTIAC, April 30—Capturing nine firsts to four for the invading Lansing Sexton high school triad, Pontiac Chiefs Friday ran away with the first dual meet between the schools, 65-46.

Gene Frazier was the Big Reds' top man. The speedy colored lad took the century and the furiong dashes. However, the meet's big point winner was Lester Smith, jumper and hurdler, who had two firsts and a third.
