Quaker Trackers Out-Classed, 100-9

Eastern Wins Only Two Second Places at Jackson

JACKSON, May 11 — Lansing Eastern's track team found Jackson high's team as warm Tuesday night as the weather was cold. The Quakers won only two second places as Jackson piled up a 100 to 9 decision in a dual meet, the second ever held here under the lights.

Jackson swept all three places in six events and set meet records in the mile 440 and 880-yard runs, broad jump, pole vault and shot put.

Eastern's seconds were by Bond in the 440-yard dash and Newman who gained a tie for second in the high jump.

Jackson's Bill Rogers copped both hurdles races and the broad jump.
