

CINDER SQUAD WHIPS ST. JOE THINLIES, 67-42

Witt Wins 2 Events To Lead Tigers; Dick Scholm No. 1 Bear

Comprising with a thoroughly re-arranged lineup of cindermen, Coach Joe Rogers' Benton Harbor high school track team romped over St. Joe's thinlies yesterday afternoon at Flatrop field to register their first official track and field triumph of the season. The Tigers were triumphant by a 67-42 count.

With Gary Reaker and Arnold Rosenberger still out of action because of indigestibility, Cliff Appelget recouped a lack injury to add to his ankle hurts just before the meet, and Les Blumenthal, busy with the basketball, Rogers was forced to run several youths in races they were unfamiliar with and change his relay setup. But his changes came through.

Notable of those coming into the scoring columns in certain events for the first time was the victory of husky Dick Witt in the 100-yard dash. He checked Stan Weber, who also was running that race for the first time. Warren "Archie" Threl made it a clean sweep for the Har- borites in that event; Weber man- aged a second in the 200, also a new race to him, and Willie Cressshaw topped third in that race for an- other Tiger sweep.

STAKE NINE FIFTEES
Benton Harbor took nine of 13 titles, having met 4 its trouble from versatile Dick Scholm, St. Jo- eph athlete who topped three finals and a third. The Bears managed on- ly one other first, that by Jay Ann in the mile run, the day's finest race. In Dick Remmer New Benton Har- bor's top miler, came from behind in the stretch to make a thrilling finish, but lacked two yards from overtaking the courageous Little Ann. The mile was run in 4:41.1.

While Scholm was the individual star of the day with victories in the two hurdle races and the shot put, and a third in the broad jump, Ben- ton Harbor had four men to score in two or more events. Dick Witt was the Tigers' top man with triumphs in the 100 yard dash and shot putt, and a third in the shot putt. Warren Jenkins won the 200 yard dash and was third in the 100, while Weber, more consistently, was second in each. Doc Tucker was the fourth man to figure in two events. He won the high jump, and then placed third in the high hurdles.

For St. Joseph, George Cressdale, who ran second in both the hurdle races, was the only athlete besides Scholm to place in two events.

Although the meet ended rather anticlimactically, it was nip-and-tuck to the finish. St. Joe leading, 40-27, be- fore the final four events. Then, Benton Harbor swept scoring in the 200-yard dash and the 800-yard run, won a 2-2 advantage in the high jump and topped the half-mile relay to mount the somewhat lopsided score.
