

Irish 4th At Mt. Pleasant

Saginaw High Wins Class A Laurels.

MT. PLEASANT - Kalamazoo St. Augustine, with Gil Eady on the sidelines with another leg injury, finished fourth in the Class C-D division of the Central Michigan Relays here Saturday.

Eady, star dash man for the Irish, hurt his leg in the 100-yard dash preliminaries and was out for the rest of the meet. Last week he pulled a leg-muscle in a triangular at Plainwell.

Coach Bill Rajkovich's thinclads, however, came away with two firsts, two thirds, a fourth and a tie for fourth. Phil Kavanaugh won the mile run in 4:46.1, and the Greenclad team of Dick Kennedy, Art Redmond, Dick Curry and Tom Wallace captured the shuttle hurdle relay in 1:05.8.

The Kalamazooans also netted thirds in the central relay and the sprint medley, a fourth in the middle distance relay and a tie for fourth in the 440-yard relay. They lost out in the central relay by a mere fraction of a second, and the injured Gil Eady was sorely missed.

Charlevoix won the Class C-D section with 41½ points, South Lake was second with 38 3/5, Reed City was third with 36 and St. Augustine was fourth with 34 1/7 in a field of over 40 schools.

In Class A, Saginaw high easily outdistanced its nearest rival, Arthur Hill, in piling up 79 points.
