

## Six Local Girls Place in Five-A Track Meet Here

Six Battle Creek high school girls placed in the Second Annual Five-A conference track and field day events, here yesterday on the local high school athletic field.

Approximately 100 girls from Lansing Sexton, Ann Arbor, Jackson, Lansing Eastern and Battle Creek took part in the program. Competition was broken into teams designated by color ribbons. Girls from all the schools made up the various teams. Thus, no school championship was decided.

Jackie Settler of Battle Creek topped the locals by tying Sherie Swoverland of Ann Arbor in the high jump at 4 feet, 2 inches. Connie Besser of Battle Creek gained a fourth place tie in the same event.

Another Battle Creek girl, Nancy Chase, was second to Marie Teranova of Lansing Eastern in the softball throw while Joan Alling scored another Battle Creek second behind Charon Hall of Ann Arbor in the 50 yard dash. Westa Sharpensteen of Battle Creek placed fourth in the broad jump which was won by Margie Davies of Ann Arbor.

Winning time in the 50 yard dash was 6.8 seconds while the best softball throw was 165 feet and the best distance in the broad jump was 13 feet, two inches.
