

Marshall Finishes 2nd In River Rouge Relay

ANN ARBOR—In one of the closest finishes of the 13-year history of the River Rouge Relays, Flint Northern made off with the class A title, East Jackson won the combined C-D championship and Monroe took the class B crown for the second straight year.

Seven records were smashed as the three winners emerged from a huge field of close to 1,000 high school athletes who jammed Michigan's Yost fieldhouse in afternoon and evening sessions.

Ann Arbor Edged

Flint Northern's balanced aggression scored 28 points to nose out Ann Arbor.

Ann Arbor by half a point and Dearborn by a full point.

The win gave Flint Northern the title vacated by Saginaw Arthur Hill, which did not enter the meet this year.

Ecorse, the only successful defending champion, scored 29½ points. Marshall was close behind with 27½ points and Roseville scored 27.

The closest finish of the meet was staged by East Jackson, which scored 20 points to take the C-D crown won last year by Berrien Springs. That was just one-tenth of a point better than runner-laming Everett.

Two class A records were erased and Jim Deily of Ypsilanti turned in a 1:40 mile performance to replace the 4:44 record set by Jim Arno of Battle Creek in 1951. The other class A record was a 1:28 low hurdle performance turned in by Dearborn's Root of Wyandotte to knock one-tenth of a second off the meet record held by a number of athletes.

Root also tied the high hurdle record in 8.2 and was voted outstanding athlete in the class. The outstanding class B athlete, Dan Goodhill of Mt. Pleasant, established a new shot put record of 53 feet 10 inches, 20 inches better than the former record.

Marshall's sprint medley team of Darwood Curtis, Al Connel, Ed Burns and Ken Coleman, set a new record of 3:12. Ray Eggleston of East Jackson was the outstanding C-D athlete. His high jump of 5 feet 11½ inches was a new meet Director Elmer Swanson's record. The high jumper was also tying 7.8 performance in the low hurdle.

The fine spring weather enabled more part of the events outdoors from Yost fieldhouse during the afternoon. The weather had no permitted this for the last four years.

A total of 84 schools sent entries to the meet.
