

Saginaw Wins Title In Class A

ANN ARBOR, May 26 — Frank Valle of Benton Harbor picked one of the worst possible days here Saturday to make his best half-mile run.

Sloshing through water-logged track at the University of Michigan Valle placed second in a section of the 880-yard run at the state Class A track finals. He covered the distance in 2:04 to pick up Benton Harbor's only points in the meet. Saginaw's Pildner edged out Valle in the fast time of 2:04.

The three points collected by Valle landed the Tigers in 20th place. Favored Saginaw captured the Class A title with 21 followed by Pontiac, 19; Highland Park, 18½, and Kalamazoo, 18.

East Jackson high won a tie for the Class C championship on the efforts of Roy Eggleston who scored all of his teams 24 points with firsts in the high jump, broad jump, high hurdles, and low hurdles. East Jackson shared the Class C honors with Ann Arbor U.

Faw Paw, led by Bud Breed who scored a fourth in the 100-yard dash and a fifth in the 220 and broad jump, wound up with seven points and a tie for 14th place in Class C. Berrien Springs tied for 25th.

Charles Harding of Berrien Springs placed fourth in the Class C low hurdles.

Benton Harbor's Fred Klemm hit 11 feet in the pole vault — two inches short of putting him among the placers. Irving Clauser high jumped 5 feet 9 inches and needed another inch to earn sixth place. All other Benton Harbor entries finished out of contention.

Field events were held indoor at Yost Fieldhouse because of a heavy rain in the morning.
