

Roseville Captures 'B' Crown

EAST LANSING, May 26 — Roseville annexed the state class B track title here Saturday, beating out a field of 51 teams.

Roseville scored 33 points and boasted the meet's top individual competitor in Robert Zimmerman who took firsts in the broad jump and 220-yard dash and ran anchor man on the winning 880-yard relay team.

Tiny Brethren rolled up 46 2/5 points in taking first place in three events to win the state class D crown. Edwardsburg, winner of last week's class D regional meet at Kalamazoo, finished second in Saturday's state meet with 20 2/5 points.

Niles, one of the Berrien county area's Class B favorites, finished a 13th with 7 1/2 points. The Vikings lone first was annexed by their medley relay team of Charlie Allen, Dick MacNeal, Gordon Rollert and Larry Cochran.

Cadillac, the meet's defending champion, finished second with 16 points.

Edwardsburg had one first place winner in taking runner-up honors in the class D meet. Don French romped home first in the first heat of the 440-yard run in 56.7 seconds.

The Eddies' Jim Hanson took sixth in the 180-yard low hurdles, fourth in the 120-yard high hurdles and finished in a 15-way tie for second in the high jump. Dan Hoover of Edwardsburg annexed third in the 220-yard dash.

New Troy's Trojans finished eighth in the class D meet, annexing one first. Jerry Peterson romped home in first the 180-yard low hurdles event; Junior Schaffer was second in the 440-yard run; Chuck
