

# Union Trio Qualifies at Ann Arbor

## Central, Catholic Stars Eliminated in State Track Meet

Ann Arbor—Three Grand Rapids Union High track athletes qualified in their special events as the state class A meet got under way here Saturday morning.

A steady downpour of rain provided a muddy track at Ferry field, but times were not too poor despite the fact. All field events were moved into Yost fieldhouse.

Billy LeBaron of Union won his heat in the 100-yard dash with a time of 10.6. Johnny Frueh, also of Union, finished second in his heat which was won in 10.6. Johnny Johnson of Kalamazoo set the best time for the century with a 10.4. Catholic's Roman Zobro, scheduled to run in that heat, was scratched.

### Fail in Broad Jump.

Jule Bush of Union qualified in both hurdles. He placed second in the high and third in the lows. Duane Brunn and Bill Kubilius, both of Catholic, failed to qualify.

Grand Rapids representatives in the shotput and broad jump also fell by the wayside. Central's Clarence (Bobo) Bouknight, pushed the iron ball 45 feet 11 inches but failed to get into the scoring. Top heave of the morning was 52 feet 3 inches.

Terry Barr and Dave Thompson, both of Central, missed out in the broad jump, neither reaching the required distance to qualify for the final leaps.
