Cardinals Sweep UP Track Trials
Coach Yatchko's hard working Cardinals overcame themselves with glory last Saturday when they literally walked off with the Central States U. S. competition at the Michigan State Fairgrounds in East Lansing. Led by double first place winner Jerry Sabulka, the Cardinals won 14 of 19 points in last the state meet. The nearest competitor was able to score 21 points as presently of all.

Sabulka swept both hurdles and under in the third place 100 yard race to lead the scoring. The only other state winner was Stinson, who placed fifth from Mounting. Other Central States place winners were Bob Mathon and John Seneca in the pole vault and high jump respectively.

The championships were not especially well attended for a state meet. Team and individual records were not set, being notably weak in the hurdles and the quarter mile. These two weeks were rather balanced mainly by very uneven distribution in the vault and high jump, which the girls double event the balance in their favor.

This championship is the first track title in Central history and was the result of long hours of patient work on individual teams by the track stars themselves and by Coach Yatchko. In five years Yatchko's teams have been runners up twice and winners their efforts with the championship this year.

Yesterday last year's champion backed up into runner up spot by means of a Houghton disqualification. In the last event the last relay team, Houghton, coming in fourth in this event would have held second place by one mark of a point 21.5 to 23, but the Green's relay was disqualified by virtue of an illegal baton in change and dropped to third place.

Other class winners at Houghton were the Senior Class B and Pole Vault, competing in track for the first time in days.
