

Coach, Pupil Vie for Title

Weaver and Dues Wage Track Duel

Malcolm Weaver, the coach, and Leroy Dues, the pupil, are waging a duel for the Metropolitan League's East Side track championship and the pupil looks like the winner.

Weaver now coaches Northern's track squad while Dues handles Miller's athletes. But back in 1927, Weaver just out of college, was track coach at Northwestern and Dues was his best shotputter, a state champion.

Miller and Northern outclassed all other schools in the first six events at Denby Monday. Miller entries won four firsts and Northern the others. Miller piled up a comfortable lead with 536.7 points to Northern's 366.7 and the margin should stand up in the remaining seven events.

No other school was close. Southeastern had 10 points; Pershing 94.7; Northeastern 76.7; Eastern 1; Denby 2 and Cass 16.7.

Miller won the shot put, high jump, 110 and 120 yard high hurdles with Northern taking the 100 and the medley relay.

Bob Farmer and Chuck Sherrill ran 1-2 in the 100-yard dash for 11 of Northern's points.

West Side schools stage the first half of their meet at Redford today. At the same time, Parochial League holds the opening events in their meet in U. of D. Stadium. Catholic Central won the team title last year.
