

## Wins Both Boys Championships

Lincoln school won both the boys and girls championships in track and field competition held this week at Longfellow school.

Lincoln piled up 3,400 points in girls contests held Tuesday, compared with 3,220 for Van Raalte, 2,820 for Longfellow and 2,725 for Washington.

But in the boys division Thursday, it was a different story. Lincoln barely edged past the next two schools in line. Final scores were Lincoln 2,775, Van Raalte 2,770, Washington 2,760 and Longfellow 2,500.
