

DOMINATES EAST SIDE

Miller Captures 7th Track Title

Not even a 20 mile per hour wind, whirling diagonally across Denby's dusty track, could halt Miller and Northern Wednesday in a record windup to the East Side track and field championships.

Miller, which got off to a great lead in Monday's opening session, came back to score heavily in every event except the mile to tuck away the sectional crown for the seventh straight year.

THE TALENTED Trojans did it with an awesome total of 103 5/14 points—a collection unmatched in league history.

Northern's great relay combination, hampered by the loss of Alvin Jackson, still had enough speed left with Marcellus Walker substituting to provide the first running record of the league meets.

Despite the heavy wind, the flying combination of Don McGuin, Walker, Bob Farmer and Chuck Sherrill sliced three tenths of a second off the mark of 1:31.3, set by Cooley in 1948.

Sherrill also took the 220 over Farmer, avenging his loss to the slender six-footer in the first-day's 100-yard duel. The wind obviously hampered the field here, however. Sherrill's winning time of :22.7, and Farmer's runnerup :22.8, was considerably below their best performances.

IN THE TEAM fight, Northern was a distant runnerup with 72 5/14 points, a total which in most years is good enough to win. No one else was within shouting distance.

Other individual winners were Cass' Joe Babb, with a 4:44.8 mile; Northern's Bill McIntosh, with a jump of 21 feet 5 1/4 inches in the broad jump, and Pershing's Jay McKenzie, with a 2:05.9 half-mile.

The scene shifts Thursday to Redford, for the West Side finals, beginning at 3 p. m.

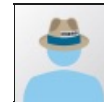
