

Wins as Expected

Miller had no trouble running off with the Metropolitan League's East Side championship on Denby's track Wednesday, scoring 103 $\frac{5}{14}$ points to 72 $\frac{5}{14}$ for Northern, the runnerup.

No other schools were close. Pershing had 23 $\frac{4}{7}$; Northeastern, 22 $\frac{12}{14}$; Southeastern, 22 $\frac{1}{2}$; Denby, 13 $\frac{1}{2}$; Cass, 7 $\frac{6}{7}$ and Eastern 7.

Seven events were held Wednesday. Willie Wright of Miller won the low hurdles and tied his teammate, Curtis Brock for first in the pole vault. Bill McIntosh, Northern, led in the broad jump; Chuck Sherrill, Northern, took the 220; Joe Babb, Cass, was first in the mile; Jay McKenzie, Pershing, won the half mile and Northern won the sprint relay.

Wright also placed first in the high hurdles Monday and was the meet's leading scorer with 17 $\frac{1}{2}$ points.

Northwestern was favored to win the West Side meet from Redford and Central at Redford today.

Six place winners in each event of the sectional meets qualify for the league's semifinals next Tuesday.
