## He Takes 3 Firsts in Track Meet

**Northern Second  
in Nip-Tuck Event**

Things were looking mighty rough Thursday afternoon for young Willie Wright.

Here he was at the end of a brilliant high school career, sent up against the toughest field he had ever faced, with the highest stakes he had ever seen—and there was that bad ankle.

Willie had sprained it in Tuesday's qualifying for the City League track and field championships. It hurt somethin' awful, he said.

In the end, though, the ankle didn't matter. Nor did anything else. Young Willie, captain of Miller High's powerful Trojans, came through it all with flying colors, as they say.

He slipped off with three first places—a rare feat in City League track—to pull his Trojans to a narrow two-point victory over Northern on windswept Sawyer Field.

IT WAS AS tight a finish as the league had seen in recent years. Miller had no other first places to go along with Wright's, but it piled up 56½ points. Northern was second with 54½ and Northwestern third with 45.

So undecided was the outcome that the championship wasn't waved to Miller until the concluding event, the pole vault. And it was there that Wright, who surely would have been the league's 440 champion this year had he chosen to stick with it, was at his best.

Young Willie soared to 11' 8" on his last vault to win the event over Redford's Dick Anderson and wind up his big show. The six points he got, plus 1½ more by Curtis Brock, put Miller into the final lead.

Earlier, Willie produced a pair of minor upsets when heading the Trojans back to the title they won in 1950.

He licked Northwestern Zebedee Damard in the high and low hurdles in 14.9 and 12.4.

It took some rough breaks to keep the title away from Northern.

THE FLEET-FOOTED Eskimos lost a second place in the medley relay, when Marcellus Walker cut too sharply and disqualified the team.

Then in the sprint relay, when Northern recently cracked the league record, Bob Farmer's old muscle injury came back suddenly and the Eskimos were a poor third behind Northwestern and Miller.
