

Miller Runs Past 3rd Track Rival

Powerful Miller High, the East Side favorite, swept to its third straight track and field victory Friday, whipping Eastern, 621/2 to 46%.

Hurdler Lloyd Swanson led the Trojans, capturing the highs in :15.8 and the lows in :13.8. Miller had another double-winner in Don Thomas, who took the 100 in :11 and the 220 in :24.6.

Despite its loss, Eastern produced the meet's outstanding performance when Fred Hopgood leaped 22 feet three inches, the spring's best distance in the City League, to win the broad jump.

NORTHERN WON 12 events as it routed U. of D., 91 to 16. Roger Dillworth took the low hurdles for the Cubs' lone victory.

Northern was led by Don Mc-Cuin, who won the 100 and 220 in :10.5 and :23, and Jim Landrum, winner in the high hurdles and high jump, second in the low hurdles and third in the broad jump.
