Howell High Wins Region Track Meet

ANN ARBOR, May 16—Faced by versatile Marshall Borden, who won both dashes, placed second in the shot put, and ran a leg with the victorious 880-yard relay team, Howell high school today won the Class B section of the Ann Arbor regional track meet.

Powerful Flint Northern, a favorite for state honors at East Lansing next week, amassed 62½ points to win the Class A regional section.

Howell, gaining qualifying spots in 11 events for next week's state Class B title meet here, rolled up 57 1/5 points to 48¼ for second place Walled Lake and 26 3/5 for third place Albion. Eaton Rapids finished eighth in the 11-school Class B field with six points.

Aside from Borden in three individual events, Howell qualified its hurdling twins, Bob (2nd) and Dick (3rd) Brown in the lows, Lynn Holley (1st—4:46) in the mile run and (3rd) in the broad jump, Milne Brewer (1st—:54.4) in the 440, Russ Smith (2nd), in the 440, Charles Culver (2nd) in the 880, and Harold Wright (3rd) in the high jump and (3rd) in the pole vault.
