# Boy Just Made Eligible Stars for Northwestern

Credit the U. S. postal service with at least an assist if Northwestern High wins the Metropolitan League's west side track meet tomorrow.

The mails came through just in time to make Fred Bradley eligible and he qualified in three events yesterday as Northwestern gained 18 places to Redford's 19 in the trials on Redford's track.

Bradley, a 17-year-old 6 footer, moved to Detroit from Cameron, Tex., where he was a state champion among Negro schoolboys. His school records were slow in arriving, however, and Coach Jimmy Russell did not use him until certain the boy was eligible.

### MISSES LONG JUMP

Northwestern's new athlete was an added starter in the broad jump and led with a leap of 21 feet 7 inches. Actually, he hit 23 feet on the jump but fell back and the measurement was taken from the point where the mark of his hand could be seen.

Bradley also qualified in the high jump and pole vault, missing out in the 100-yard dash.

Except for the shot put in which it missed out, Northwestern's places were well distributed with one each in the 220, 440, mile and pole vault; two in the 100, half mile, high and low hurdles; three in the broad and high jumps.

### PACKS THREE EVENTS

Redford's strength was concentrated in the half and mile, in each of which it had four qualifiers, and the pole vault with

three. Redford also placed one in low and high hurdles, 220, 440, high and broad jumps and two in the shot put.

Other schools having entries in the finals: Cooley, 13; Mackenzie, 10; Southwestern, 6; Central, 6; Mumford, 4; Chadsey, 2; Western, 2; Cody, 1.

Miller was favored in the east side finals today.
