**St. Joe Clinches Title**

St. Joseph High School clinched its first Catholic League track title in history Wednesday at University of Detroit.

The Blue Jays with depth and balance picked up points in all nine events held to roll up a formidable 63 points in the two-day meet. Only the high jump, low hurdles and

880-yard relay are left to be completed Thursday.

De LASALLE held down second place after Wednesday's action with 32 points and had no mathematical chance of heading off its downtown rival.

Two records were set by

De LaSalle entrants. Bob Cosiglia turned in a :52.5 440 and Marv Boroski threw the shot 46 feet 9 1/4 inches.

St. Joseph reached its peak in the 880 when it won the first three places with George Fiedler, Don Buback and Paul Halkey finishing in that order. The summaries:
