## Howell Easy Track Winner

HOWELL, May 29 — Scoring heavily in every event, Howell high — a Class B regional meet winner this year—sauntered off with the Capital Circuit conference track and field title here Thursday night.

The host team, paced by Marshall Borden, who won three firsts plus running a leg on a winning relay team, won eight of the events and tied for another to accumulate 78 1-5 points.

Charlotte and Lansing Everett staged a two-team race for second with the Orioles coming out on top, 41 3-5 to Everett's 40 3-5. Eaton Rapids was third with 14 points, followed by Mason with 14 and Grand Ledge with 4 3-5.

Everett was the defending champion.

A sudden dip in temperature just before the night meet started kept all performances away from record times and distances.

Borden was easily the outstanding individual in the meet, but the Howell senior had plenty of help from his teammates to make the affair a walk-away for Coach Loren Willis' crew. The Brown twins — Dick and Bob — divided the hurdle honors. Dick won the highs (Bob was third) and Bob won the lows (Dick was second). Dick was also

third in the shotput and the brothers each ran a leg with Borden and Glen Catrell on the winning half-mile relay team.

Everett won three of the four firsts Howell did not account for. The Viking medley relay team of Dick Balow, George Price, Norm Henrys and Bill Woodland won in 2:41.2 minutes.

Price, who set a new Class C state pole vault record at 11 feet 9 inches last Saturday, tied for first with Teammate Dick Content at 11 feet.

Bob Prince earned Everett's other first, pacing the field in the half mile.

Chuck Connelly of Eaton Rapids won the broad jump.

Other Howell winners were Lynn Holly, who easily defended his mile title and Milne Brewer, quarter-mile.

Howell's strongest event was the shotput, where it picked up 12 points with a first, second, and third.

Charlotte earned most of its points with second-place winners. Joe Iauch trailed Borden to the wire in both sprints, for the Orioles. Other Charlotte seconds were Chuck Sherd in the high hurdles, Dean Carey in the quarter, and the Oriole half-mile relay team.

Janice Whalen, Howell senior, was queen of the meet and presented the first place medals to the winners. She had a court who presented the other medals.
