### Blue Jays Set Parochial Mark

St. Joseph High hit the track and field jackpot Thursday.

The Blue Jays rolled a record 75 9/10 points to claim their first Catholic League track title in history.

St. Joseph, coached by Brother James, completed the two-day test Thursday at University of Detroit by setting records in both the low hurdles and 880-yard relay.

**JIM KOSSEK** won the 180-yard lows in the record time of :20.9 and established a mark of 1:35.9 in the 880-yard relay with Kossek, Tom Straszewski, John Lewandowski and Duke Scrafano carrying the baton.

St. Joseph won five firsts and seven seconds in its record-smashing charge.

Other team scores: DeLaSalle 44½, Servite 27¾, Orchard Lake St. Mary 14½, St. Bernard 9½, St. Paul 7, Shrine 3 and St. Thomas 1.
