# Parochial Stars Set Three Marks

Parochial League athletes broke three more records yesterday for a total of five in two days, as St. Joseph ran off with its first track championship in U. of D. Stadium.

Bob Mansfield of De La Salle and Bob Plummer, St. Bernard, leaped 5 feet 8 $\frac{3}{4}$  in the high jump. Jim Kossek, St. Joseph, ran the 180-yard low hurdles in :20.9 and then joined Tom Straszewski, John Lewandowski and Duke Scrafano to win the half-mile relay in 1:35.9.

St. Joseph scored 75.9 points and De La Salle, the runnerup, 44 $\frac{1}{2}$ . Other scores: Servite 27 $\frac{3}{4}$ ; Orchard Lake St. Mary 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ ; St. Bernard 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ ; St. Paul 7; Shrine 3; St. Thomas 1.
