Saginaw High School Wins nvitational Track Meet

Pontiac High Second

Saginaw, winners of the tournament two years ago, topped Pontiac High, second place winners with 32½ points. Defending champion Flint Northern was third with 29 3/7.

Tom Hall, of Saginaw, sped over the 65-yard high hurdles in :8.15, bettering his old mark of :8.4 set last year.

A Saginaw High's four-lap relay team turned in a 1:16 race, clipping a full second off the mark set by Flint Northern in 1953.

Traverse City won the middle distance medley relay in 6:13 to beat the record of 6:22 set by Dearborn Fordson in 1953.

High jumper Ed Ringgold of Pontiac cleared 6 feet, 1 inch to top the old mark of 6 feet set by Lee King of Saginaw in 1952.

Another of King's marks fell when Joe Boyden of Muskegon High put the shot 52 feet, 4% inches. The old mark, set by King in 1952, was 51 feet, 1 inch.

Boyden, a 2301/2-pound, 6-foot-4 senior heaved the iron ball over 50 feet in all seven of his attempts.
