

Prep Marks Fall Early at Mt. Pleasant

MT. PLEASANT — Three records went by the boards here Friday night in early events of the annual Saginaw High-Arthur Hill invitational Class A indoor track meet.

Joel Boyden, 260-pound Muskegon High senior, tossed the shot 52 feet, 4 7-8 inches for a meet record.

Tom Hall, Saginaw High hurdler, skipped over the 65-yard high hurdles in :08.15 to better the old mark of :08.5 held by Art Liles, of Arthur Hill.

A Traverse City medley relay team won in 6:13, a record.

Although it wasn't a record leap, Charles Thrash, Flint Central broad jumper, won his event by doing 21 feet 6 3-4 inches.

Flint Northern's Art Johnson won the 60-yard dash as expected in :06.4.
