

Al Wright Garners 15 Points

Mackenzie Trims Western Squad

Pershing's unbeaten track and field team shrugged off one of its strongest challengers for East Side supremacy Thursday as it walloped Eastern, 57 9/10 to 30 1/10 in a dual meet.

Al Wright collected 15 points for the Doughboys, who earlier had whipped Miller's defending champions in a dual clash. Wright won both hurdle events and the broad jump.

EASTERN'S BEST came from Vern LaFaive, who took the 100 and 220. It was the sixth Pershing victory.

Cass, another East Side power, ran over Southeastern, 76 to 33. Ed Thompson won both hurdles, Paris Whittington took the 440 in excellent :53.6 and Herman Crutcher won the 220 in :23.1.

Mackenzie trounced Western, 81 to 29, with Norm Zackiewicz leading the hurdles in :13.4 and :15.4 and Narin Miller winning the sprints in :10.5 and :23. Northern slammed five events while dropping Mumford, 84 to 24.

Double victories by Don Funderburg in the hurdles and William Harrison in the sprint gave Southwestern a 60½-48½ edge over Redford.
