Redford Takes Own Prep Relays

Host Redford took only four out of the 12 first places but collected unexpected points in enough events to win the sixth annual Redford High School Relays Saturday.

Coach Bruce Waha's squad won top honors with 70 points. Last year Redford was second to Eastern which Saturday finished in a tie for the runnerup spot with Pershing, each totaling 56 points.

Central was fourth with 41, followed by Southwestern 24, Northwestern 19, Cooley 14, Mumford 13, Mackenzie 12, Cody 11, Cass and Northeastern 10 each, Southeastern 8, Denby 6, Western 5 and Osborn 2.
