

Shirley Young Third in Dash At Buffalo Meet

Buffalo, N. Y.—Shirley Young of Flint copped a third place in the 50-yard dash here Sunday in the girl's division of the annual Firemen's Invitational track meet.

Miss Young was a half-step behind the winner who was clocked at 8.9 seconds. It was the best performance of Michigan Girls' Track and Field Club over the week end.

Both Miss Young and Mary Jane Kenney ran on the 440-yard relay team which finished fifth in the girls' division of the Canadian National AAU track meet Saturday in Toronto. Miss Young was eliminated in the semi-finals of the 50-yard dash at Toronto.

Carl Groth, coach of the Michigan team, was impressed by both Flint newcomers to his track team. He said officials at both the Buffalo and Toronto meets had extended an invitation for next year. The powerful Chicago CYO girls won team honors at both meets.
