Hills' Non-Grad Track Team Wins Meet At Bay City

Midland, Bay City Central Squads Fall As Hills Grab Nine Firsts.

BAY CITY—Arthur Hill romped to an easy win over Bay City and Midland in a triangular track meet for non-graduates and non-qualifiers for state meet competition yesterday. The Lumberjack under-classmen piled up 68½ points with Bay City Central placing second with 38 11/12 and Midland third with 30¾.

Arthur Hill grabbed nine undisputed first places and shared two others in the 13-event meet.

Jerry Rifenburg and Leon Dubay were double winners for Arthur Hill.

Rifenburg skimmed over the 120-yard high hurdles in 16.8 seconds and was clocked in 22 seconds for the 180-yard low hurdles.

Dubay placed first in the 100-yard dash in 11 seconds and added another win in the 220 in 24.8 seconds.

Arthur Hill won all but one of the running events. Don Brown placed first in the mile in 4:48.6, Tony Sova won the half-mile in 2:12.5, and both Lumberjack relay teams won.

A medley relay combination of Tom Williams, Bob Gay, Gary Murphy and Ron Martin won in 2:43.5, while Arthur Hill's 880 relay team of Rifenburg, Martin, Murphy and Dubay placed first in 1:40.1.

Jim Alexander gave Arthur Hill a win in the broad jump with an 18-foot-10¾ leap. Bill Franz tied with three others for first in the high jump, while Jim Grinnell tied with Bob O'Farrell of Bay City in the pole vault, each clearing 9-foot-10 for Arthur Hill's first-place shares.

Oscar Hahn of Midland won the shot put with a toss of 40 feet-10. Bay City Central's only first place was produced by Mike Neering in the 440.
