

# Wrap Up 2 Titles

Two baseball titles were wrapped up in yesterday's Catholic High School League play.

Shine captured the west side First Division championship by defeating Lourdes 2-0 on Grant Becker's three hitter. Newell Whitney scored both of the knights runs. He walked in the second and after stealing second and third scored on a wild pitch. He walked again in the third and scored on Tom Rogers' single.

## St. Cyril Unbeaten
