eclipsed such other fine conference performances as a 117 victory by William Thomson of Illinois over the high hurdles and Thomson's 27.2 clocking in the low hurdles in the Big Ten relay.

Defending Champion Illinois has four of the spring's best performances, also including a 47.7 time in the 430 by English Freeman and 1:32.3 by Henry Cryer in the 500.

Well-balanced Michigan has three best conference times and shares in two other top performances this spring. Wolverine Tom Wallington has ledged low two-hurdle in 21.8. Michigan's relay team has done 2:15.3 and broad jumper Hendricks has topped 24-2 1/2.

English Horse Sets Mark In Taking Dixie Handicap

BALTIMORE, May 21 (AP)—St. Vincent, a 4-year-old English bred, continued to find the grass greener here and ran for his second American turf record this year in winning the Dixie Handicap today at Pimlico.

The chestnut gelding rippled through the mile and three-sixteenths of the turf course in 2:15 2/5. The fastest it had been run before was 2:17 2/5 by C. Mahlon Kline's Kaster, who came in 2 1/2 lengths behind the easy striding St. Vincent.

Greentree stable's Maharajah took third place behind Kaster whose American record was set at Belmont last June. Charfran stable's Cheesman from the Ar-
