

Top Spot For Miller

Miller High today appeared a shoo-in for the East Side track title in the Metropolitan League after qualifying 22 men yesterday for tomorrow's finals.

The big gun for the Trojans was Johnny Green who topped the trials in three events. He led the 100-yard dash with a 10.2-second clocking, the 220-yard dash in 22.5 seconds and the broad jump with a leap of 21 feet 11½ inches.

Denby gained 13 qualifiers, followed by Pershing with 10, Northeastern six, Eastern five, Northern four and Southeastern and Cass Tech one each.

Shares Top Honors

Art Glover of Pershing shared top honors in both the hurdles. He and Al Bernardi of Denby were clocked in 14 seconds flat in the highs while Paul Jones of Pershing matched Glover's time of 15.8 seconds in the lows.
