East Side schoolboys captured one city track championship Wednesday and staked out a claim to another.

Servite High, the new East Side school at Warren and Lakeside, won its first Catholic League title at U. of D. Stadium, defeating St. Joseph, 62-27 to 56-27.

the East Side title in the City League at Denby High. The Trojans will bid for their third conference title in four years next week and will rule a decided favorite.

Coach LaVerne Foley, of Servite, saw his Panthers climax the school's finest season in any sport with customary power in the sprints plus Paul Maloney's victory in the half mile. Servite picked up 21 of its points in the 100, 220 and sprint relay.

Capt. Frank McQuade won the century and took second in the 220. John Marine won the 100. Maloney threw in a 3:06.2 half mile on a soggy, wind-swept course.

Miller's flashiest performer on another balanced squad was Jerry Green, Green was the day's only triple winner capturing the 100 in 16.7, the 220 in 38.2 and winning the broad jump with a leap of 21 feet 11½ inches.

THE TROJANS, however, spreadeagled the field by winning seven firsts and picking up points in all 13 events. Denby was a distant second with 56½ points. Only other exceptional performance of the day was a 4:37 mile by Denby's Jerry Boett.

West Siders completed their qualifying at Mumford Wednesday and will determine their titlist Thursday starting at 7 p.m.

Best mark among the qualifiers was Campbell Owens, of Northwestern, who was caught in .51 flat in winning the 440.

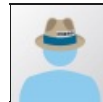
