

SERVITE BEATS ST. JOSEPH**Track Rally Too Late**

St. Joseph High's defending champions tried hard yesterday but couldn't overcome the big lead Servite built up in Tuesday's events of the Parochial League track meet at U. of D. Servite gained its first title with 62-3-7 points while St. Joseph, winner for the last two years, had 56 1-7.

Servite held a 24-13 edge after five events Tuesday.

De La Salle placed third with 36 2-7 points. St. Bernard had 19 1-7, Austin 11, Orchard Lake St. Mary 6, Cathedral 2, Notre Dame 1.

Bill Kubicz, De La Salle, was the only double winner, leading

the high and low hurdles. Frank McQuade and Paul Maloney, both of Servite, also scored 10 points. McQuade won the 100, was second in the 220 and ran on the second-place sprint relay. Maloney took the half mile, finished in a three-way tie in the pole vault and was fifth in the broad jump.

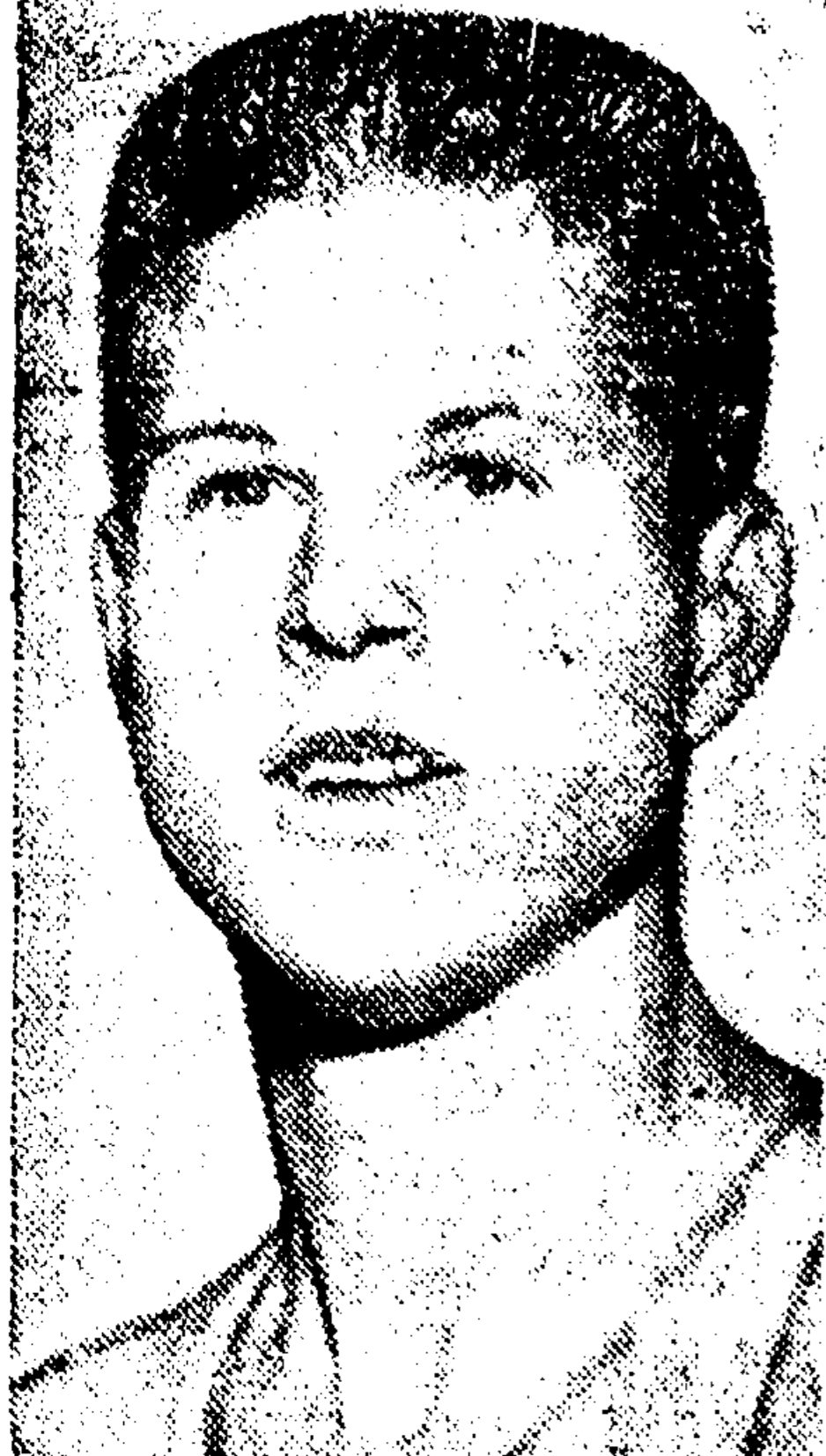

LANSING, May 26.—(AP)—The House has killed a last-minute attempt to renew the Conservation Commission's authority to set special "any deer" seasons. By an 83-2 vote, the lower chamber rejected a Senate amendment which would have extended the power for two years. It previously had buried a similar bill in committee.
