

SETS NEW TOTAL POINTS MARK

Oilers Easy Winners In Conference Meet

LUDINGTON — Piling up a record number of points, Mt. Pleasant High School won the Northern Central Class B Track Meet here yesterday with little opposition from five other schools.

The powerful Oilers grabbed seven first places and tied for two others to pace the field with 76 points to 33 of a distant second place Ludington team. Alma was fourth with 25.

Cadillac landed in third place with 31 points, while Big Rapids was fifth with 10 5/8 and

Manistee finished on the bottom at 9 1/2.

It was the highest winning point total ever recorded in the conference's nine-year history and marked the second consecutive win for the Oilers, and their fourth championship overall.

Mt. Pleasant, which finished fourth in the state Class B meet, was paced by Jerry Wiley, hurdler, and Dave Myers, sprinter, as it has been all season.

Wiley had little difficulty winning his specialties, the 180-yard low hurdles and the 120-yard high hurdles in 16.5 while Myers grabbed a first place in

the 100-yard dash in 10.7. Both contributed legs to the winning 880-yard relay team.

Although Alma failed to win any first places, the Panthers registered several second and third places to gain their 25 points and fourth spot.

In the mile run, Mt. Pleasant's Lauran Eldred lost his shoe on the first turn, running the rest of the race with one shoe and finishing a strong second to Wally Schafer of Ludington.

High winds hampered most of the track events, increasing the clocking times and making chances of any new conference records difficult.
