SETS NEW TOTAL POINTS MARK Oilers Easy Winners In Conference Meet

LUDINGTON — Piling up a record number of points, Mt. Pleasant High School won the Northern Central Class B Track Meet here yesterday with little opposition from five other schools.

The powerful Oilers grabbed seven first places and tied for two others to pace the field with 76 points to 33 of a distant second place Ludington team, Alma was fourth with 25.
