Adrian Track Team Stops Coldwater

COLDWATER — Adrian High School's up and coming track team handed Coldwater its first defeat here yesterday afternoon in a make up of a twice-postponed meet, 61 to 48.

Strong, raw winds buffeted the course and proved rough on field events participants. Two disqualifications figured in the outcome as Adrian's Harry Lewis, a winner by 30 yards in the half-mile, was disqualified. Coldwater's half-mile relay team, a winner, also was disqualified.

Dick Wells of Adrian, Twin Valley half-mile record-holder, switched to the mile yesterday and won handily. There were no double winners although Dick Hanna of Adrian won the high hurdles and tied for first in the high jump.

Coldwater's chances of victory grew slim when it was revealed that four Cardinal performers were dropped from the squad for disciplinary action by Coach Bill Fairman. The four failed to show up for a scheduled practice, giving no reasons.
