

Kearsley Lassies Eye Sixth Straight Title

Kearsley's girls track team will be out this week to win an unprecedented sixth consecutive championship when the Genesee County League gals run in the annual cinder meet at Dort Field Thursday.

The thinclads of coach Esther Price have run away with the Class B section of the meet since 1951. Of the eight events, Kearsley girls hold five meet records, all set since 1950.

Beecher trailed Kearsley last season by 16 points and the other schools finished in the order of Mandeville, Davison, Flushing, Grand Blanc and Bendle.

Swartz Creek copped the Class C title in 1955 but the previous meets were highlighted by Mandeville and Otisville. Mandeville won in 1954 and 1951. Otisville won in 1952 and 1953. Mandeville is now a Class B school and Otisville is incorporated in Lakeville.

Following Swartz Creek last season were Utley, Atherton, Gaines, Otisville, Goodrich, Bentley and Linden.

Only one record was broken in the 1955 meet but that was the oldest mark on the books.

Five new conference records

Beecher's Eliose Frechette tossed the basketball 91 feet, 10 inches to better the 1940 record of 87 feet, 3 inches set by Phyllis Austin of Bendle.

Miss Frechette was graduated last June but one record-holder will be back this Spring. She is Utley's Pat Childers, who set the running broad jump record two years ago as a 14-year-old freshman.

Miss Childers' record leap was 15 feet, 9 inches. Last year she took a first with a 15-foot effort. The Utley lass was the meet's leading point-getter last year. She garnered 15 1/4 points on firsts in the running broad jump and 75-yard dash, a second in the standing broad jump and anchored the winning 200-yard relay squad.
