

## DENBY PLACES IN 10 EVENTS

# Tars Top Track Qualifiers

Denby High stamped itself as the team to beat in Thursday's City League track finals at Redford's Sawyer Field.

The Tars, bidding for their first outdoor championship in history, will have 11 individuals and two relays in the finals and will have at least one performer in 10 of the 13 events.

**QUALIFYING** in all but the mile was held Tuesday and the Tars are well stocked in milers where Jerry Bocci, the favorite, Jack Elwarner and Tom Bleakley are ready to go.

Tuesday's top qualifying effort was turned in by Redford's Doug Carroll, who stepped to a 1:59.6 clocking in the 880, the first time he has broken two minutes this season.

Dave Lustig, of Mumford, won the 440 in :51.4.
