

Third Place To Eastern Track Team

MT. PLEASANT, April 6 (AP) — Flint Northern piled up 54.9 points to topple defending Champion Pontiac in the Class A Central Michigan college invitational high school indoor track meet last night.

Pontiac with 40 points was runner-up.

Lansing Eastern with 22.7 edged Bay City Central for third place by .7 points.

Team depth made the difference for Flint Northern. The Vikings took the 65-yard high hurdles, the 440-yard dash, the four-lap relay and tied for first in the pole vault.

Pontiac's Hudson Ray set a new meet record of 6 feet 5½ inches in the high jump. The mark topped the old record of 6 feet 1¾ inches set last year by Ray and teammate Hays Jones.

Namon Smith of Bay City Central set a new meet mark of 7.3 seconds in the 65-yard low hurdles. Smith also tied the 60-yard dash meet record of 6.3.

Other team scores: Flint Central 10.2; Traverse City 9; Saginaw Arthur Hill 6.5; Muskegon 6.2; Midland 5; Saginaw High 3.5, Alpena and Bay City Handy failed to score.

Winning points for Lansing Eastern were Dick Bailey, who tied for first in the pole vault; Don Fieghner, tied for fifth in the pole vault; Ray Auvenshine, second in the 440; Willie Austin, third in the 60-yard dash; Ken Reinhard, fourth in the 880; Ron Selfridge, third in the mile; Art Vallencourt, fifth in the mile and the relay team of Austin, Ron Gillum, Chuck West and Hank Keyton second in the four-lap event.
