Namon Smith of Bay City Central set a new meet mark of 7.3 seconds in the 65-yard low hur dies. Smith also tied the 60-yard dash meet record of 6.3.

Other team scores: Flint Central 10.2; Traverse City 9; Saginaw Arthur Hill 6.5; Muskegon 6.2; Midland 5; Saginaw High 3.5. Alpena and Bay City Handy failed to score.

Winning points for Lansing Eastern were Dick Bailey, who tied for first in the pole vault; Don Fieghner, tied for fifth in the pole vault; Ray Auvenshine second in the 440; Willie Austin third in the 60-yard dash; Ken Reinhard, fourth in the 880; Ron Selfridge, third in the mile; Arl Vaillencourt, fifth in the mile; Arl Vaillencourt, fifth in the mile and the relay team of Austin, Ror Gillium, Chuck West and Hanl Keyton second in the four-lag event.
