

Kazoo Cinder Meet OK'd by MHSAA, AAU

KALAMAZOO — (AP) — Michigan's top high school cindermen will compete here Memorial Day evening in the first annual Champion of Champions track meet.

The event sponsored by the Junior Chamber of Commerce will bring together the leading eight high school performers in each track event regardless of class. The entry list will be completed after the state track meeting Saturday.

A feature of the Memorial Day classic will be the Michigan Collegiate Miracle Mile. College milers who have already accepted include Henry Kennedy, Michigan State; Selywin Jones, Michigan State; Gerald Zitney, Michigan State Normal; and Bill Pyle and John McKenzie, both of Western Michigan.

Ron Wellington and Bob Dowlett of the University of Michigan have also been invited.

The AAU has sanctioned the Miracle Mile. The meet has been approved by the Michigan High School Athletic Assn.

Medals will be awarded, by WKZO-TV in Kalamazoo. Proceeds go to the U. S. Olympic Fund.
