Covert Grabs Class D Honors St. Joseph Wins 'B' State Track Title

ANN ARBOR—(AP)—Jason Harness, an All-State football end, piled up 16½ points and led St. Joseph High School to its fifth state Class B high school track championship yesterday at Ferry Field.

Covert high came in with a thrilling finish in the 880-yard

St. Joe football team, placed first in one section of the 440-yard dash, accounting for five points.

Harness was third in the broad jump, fourth in the 120-yard high hurdles and third in the 180-yard low hurdles in addition to his first-place tie in the high jump.

Inkster piled up 27 points.

The day's top point getter was Quincy Johnson of Covert's Class D champions. Johnson won both the broad jump and the 220-yard dash events and was a strong second in the 100-yard dash. He also
